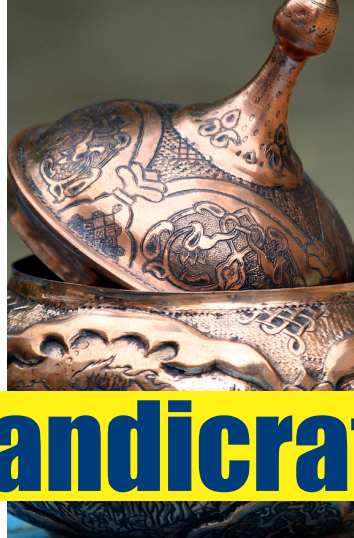
The Great Outdoors

Teaching and Learning

Isfahan University of Medical Sciences is one of the most prominent and highly-prestigious medical universities in Iran. This top-notch university is currently planning to accept students at different medical majors and levels.

Students are expected to assess and think critically about issues, rather than simply memorize information. To do well, students will need to consult different reference sources of information and evaluate, analyze and understand them. Teaching methods vary between schools, but most degrees are structured around a program of lectures. Seminars, group discussions, practicals and field trips are also often conducted.



Academic Degrees and Courses

To gain any university qualification, students must satisfactorily complete a specific academic degree. Each degree requires students to complete a certain number of courses.

Some degrees have compulsory courses, and may or may not include electives. In other degrees, students can make their own selection of courses, with the advice and approval of the school or faculty in which they are enrolled. In all cases, assessment is provided at the end of the course.



Assessment

Most courses are assessed continuously through a number of different avenues. These vary depending on the school and degree, with common forms including: essays, assignments, practicals, tutorial papers, participation in group discussions, and end-of-semester exams.



Affiliated Hospitals

MUI has 10 affiliated teaching hospitals at the moment whose functions are training medical students in real-life situations.

A teaching hospital, affiliated with a medical school, is used to train doctors, and often is involved in research. At a teaching hospital, you may encounter medical students in the final years of studying and who are training in patient care. You might also encounter fellows or residents who have graduated from medical school and are training in a specific area of medicine before they go on their own practices. Some residents are referred to as interns—these doctors are in the first year of their residency training. Some teaching hospitals have other students as well, such as nursing students. Any students who are in training in hospitals are closely supervised by others with more experience.

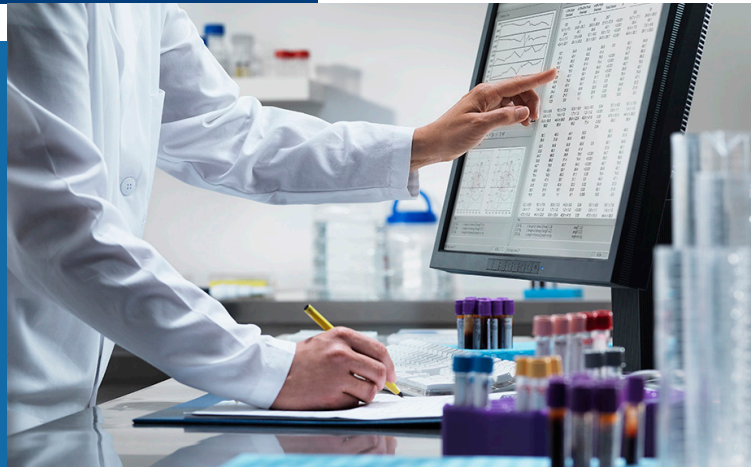
Our teaching hospitals train medical students in many fields including Cardiology, Oncology, Burns, Gynecology and other speciality and subspeciality fields.

Research opportunities feature extensive collaborations across disciplines, health institutions and health partners throughout Isfahan, Iran and internationally.

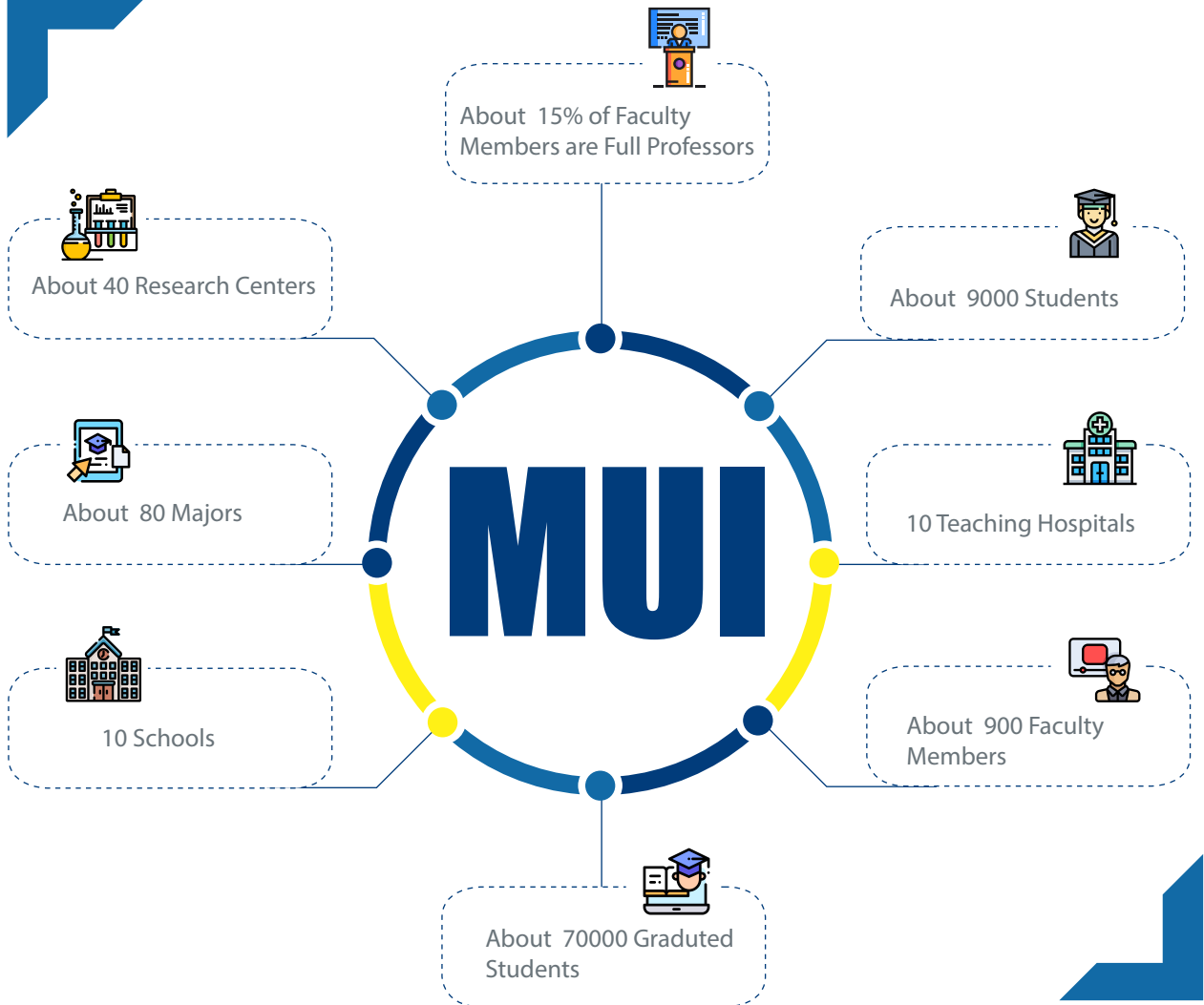

Living on campus provides our students with a live-in support network of Resident Assistants as well as close proximity to classes , study areas and athletics facilities .

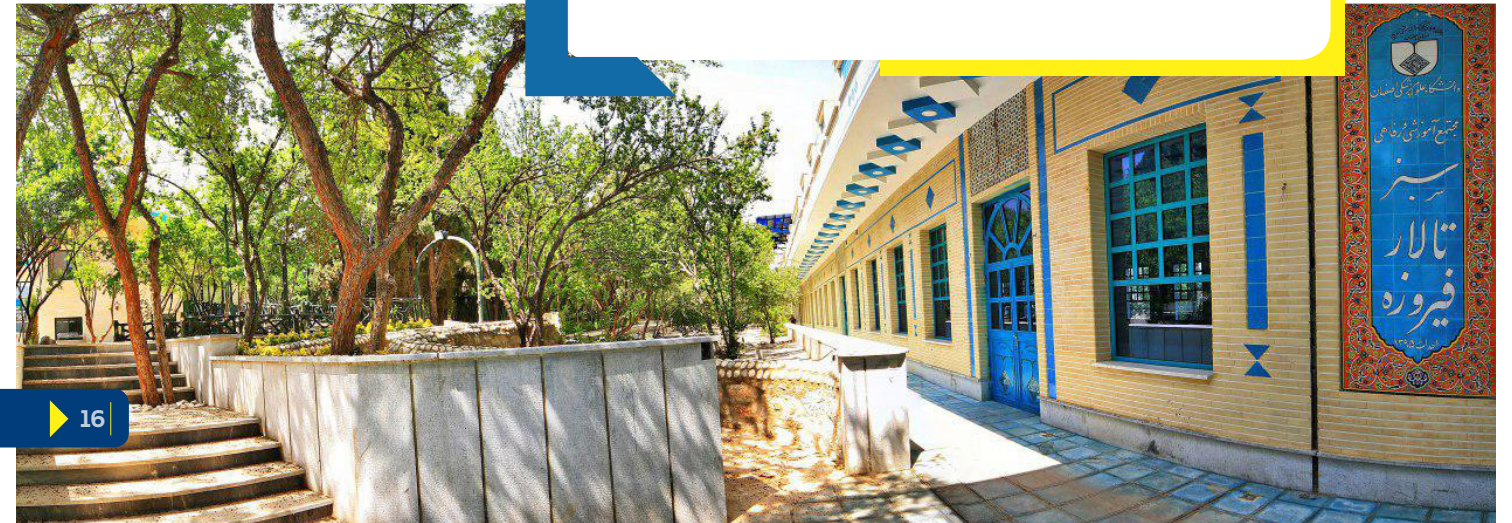

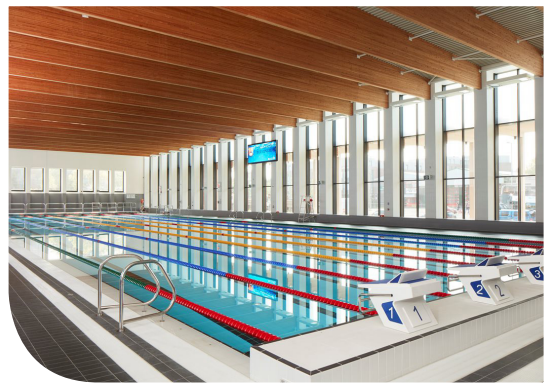
Our campus has a security office that is staffed 24 hours a day .

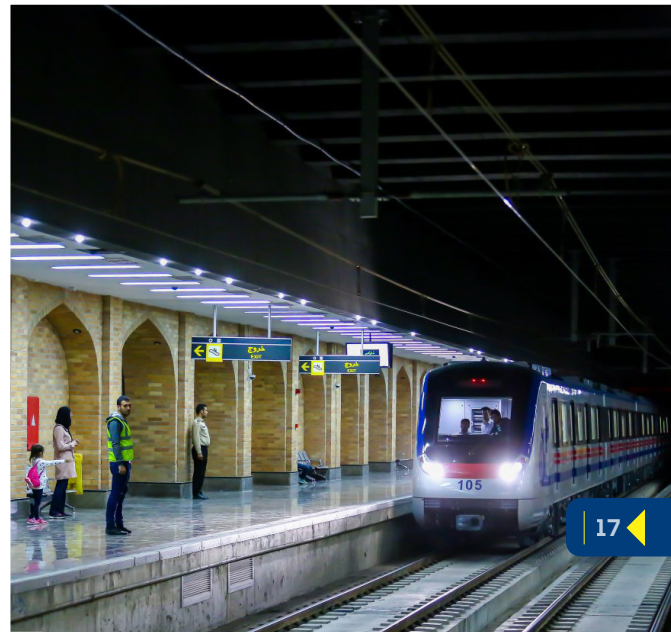
Sports at MUI
